SAMPLE FORMAT FOR DINING WITH A PURPOSE

Welcome to an exciting opportunity to host a Dining with a Purpose! You will be amazed at how much the women love getting together and being part of such an incredible vision.

So just invite a few friends over, and get started. Keep it simple, and don't over think it. Each Dining with a Purpose will take on the personality of the leaders and the team of women.

We have a sample format, and suggested ideas of what to do after the fellowship and meal.

- As people arrive, have them fill in the sign-in-sheet, and give their \$20. If someone is new, and doesn't know how it works, don't expect them to give, until they understand how it works. ~ No pressure ~ Put everything in the envelope and have it ready to pray over.
- Socialize a little, until everyone arrives. Pray for/over the offering and the meal. (We have a Prayer Declaration in the packet that you can use, you could have different people read it each time, or you can just pray on your own).
- Please delegate, make it a team effort. Don't feel like you have to do everything yourself. Have someone handle the sign in sheet, mailing in the envelope, doing the prayer declaration, developing an email list for the women who attend, etc. You can alternate homes within the women in the group.
- Enjoy your meal together.
- After you eat, take a few moments to share the vision of Women World Changers. You could read from the website, our mission statement, and information about WWC. Share the vision God gave us of One thousand women coming together to give \$1,000 a year, or host a Dining with a Purpose to raise a minimum of \$1,000 a year. When we have 1,000 women hosting monthly, with 10 women at their Dining with a Purpose it comes out to \$200,000 a month we can then give to these great causes we are supporting. WOW!
- On the website there are videos from each of the ministries we are currently supporting, and doing projects with. You can show one or two of them. You can share from the human trafficking fact sheet. As a host of a Dining with a Purpose, you will have local ministries that you get connected and involved with, you can bring in guest speakers to share about trafficking, and the other issues we are supporting.
- Keep everything short and to the point, as you want it to be concise and keep people's attention.
- When you are done with that part, you can then go to the Suggestion sheet of things to do after you are done sharing.
- Remember, keep it simple and make it fun and purposeful. As we said before, each Dining with a Purpose will reflect the leadership, and team of women attending.

Have fun! You will be amazed how excited women will get, being part of changing the world together.
